It is a pleasure to write a letter of reference for Vincent Dirks. Vincent was employed by the University of Auckland as a software engineer from September 2002 to July 2003 followed by several months of contract work. The primary focus of our laboratory is research and development of implantable sensors for use in animal based research. Our lab has developed a unique telemetry based amplifier and wireless transmitter that is radically altering the ability to collect data relating to the control of blood pressure.
